Dear Greater Lowell Tech Families,

This letter is to provide you with an update on recent changes to the public health data. Based on the Massachusetts Department of Public Health COVID-19 Report for this week, June 4, 2021: The Average Daily Incidence Rate number of cases per 100,000 residents (last 14 days) for the City of Lowell is 6.3 down from 8.0 last week. The "percent positivity rate" (the percentage of tests that are positive in Lowell) is 2.02%, down from 2.15% last week.

This week we have no school community members who have tested positive. Please continue to monitor your child DAILY for COVID symptoms before sending them school. Do NOT send your child to school if they are exhibiting symptoms of COVID which include: fever (100 degrees or higher) chills, headache (when in combination with other symptoms), body aches, cough (not associated with a known cause), difficulty breathing, nausea vomiting or diarrhea, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, fatigue (when in combination with other symptoms) and nasal congestion or runny nose.

The last day of school is Thursday, June 10, 2021, and all students will be dismissed at 10:43 a.m. The period schedule for the day will be as follows; 1, 2, 10, and 11. Students will be keeping their Chromebook for the summer and are required to bring them back to school with them in the Fall.

Thank you for your patience and partnership this school year as we navigated through these very unprecedented times. Please have a healthy and safe summer and we look forward to seeing you in the Fall!
